Open to students attending either Jefferson High School or Lake Mills High School and pursuing a degree in the medical field.

Amount: \$1,000 - \$1,500

Deadline: 3/31/2012

2. American Legion Auxiliary – Local Reinhardt-Windl #164 Jefferson

Must be a descendent of a veteran. Must be admitted to a 4-year college or technical school. Two scholarships will be awarded.

Amount: \$500 ea.

Deadline: 3/26/2012

3. Stuart C. & Gladys Anhalt – Music Memorial

Must pursue a program of study and career in instrumental music.

Amount: \$1,000+

Deadline: 3/26/2012

4. Michelle & Craig Auerbach Memorial

Must have attended Jefferson High School for a minimum of four semesters and rank in upper 1/3 of graduating class.

Amount: \$5,000 (Approx.)

5. Badger Truck Pullers Association - Glen Koeppel Memorial Scholarship

Open to students pursuing a technical career and have financial need.

Open to all Jefferson County High School seniors planning to pursue a career in the performing arts - must have maintained a 2.50 grade point average.

13. Joe E. Davies Scholarship

The candidate must have been enrolled in the participating high school for a period of not less than four semesters prior to graduation. The candidate must be a member of the current graduation class and must have maintained an overall average of "B" or better for seven semesters of high school. Must be attending UW-Madison.

14. Donald D. Dunnington Memorial Scholarship

Must have obtained a grade point average of 2.75 or better – enrolled in college, university or technical school of choice. Based on involvement in extracurricular, community and church activities.

15. FFA Alumni Scholarship

Must be majoring in agriculture at a post-secondary level.

Amount: \$500

Offered to a student with at least 50 hours of volunteer service pursuing a course of study in the healthcare field. Minimum GPA 2.75.

Based on scholastic achievement rather than financial need – must enroll in one of the 13 University of Wisconsin Campuses.

Available to any student pursuing a career in agriculture and natural resources at a two or four-year college or technical school.

25. Stuart and Stanley Hake Agriculture Scholarship

Must be a graduate of Jefferson High School in the top 1/3 of their class. Must be pursuing an agricultural-related education.

Amount: Varies

Must be pursuing any health-related field.

Amount: up to \$1,500 (3)

27. Debra Happ Memorial Scholarship

For students pursuing a degree in a performing arts field. Must be a graduate of Jefferson High School and attended for a minimum of 4 semesters. Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher.

28. Tamara (Tami) Hess Memorial Scholarship

The recipient shall be a graduate of Jefferson High School and have attended for 3 semesters. Must have a GPA of 2.25 or higher. Will be either a special education student attending a 2 or 4 year college or a student attending a 2 or 4 year college pursuing a degree in special education.

29. Scott W. Hulstein Memorial Scholarship www.forthehealthcare.com

For students pursuing a career in nursing or other health careers. Must be a high school graduate residing in Jefferson County. Must have a 3.0 GPA.

30. Jefferson Chamber of Commerce Scholarship

Must be a graduate of Jefferson High School and be employed by a business that is a member of the Jefferson Chamber of Commerce.

Majoring in agriculture or agriculture related field at a 2 or 4-year college.

For students pursuing a career in Education. Must have a 3.0 GPA.

33. Jefferson County Deputy Sheriff Association

Upper 35% of graduating class – enrolled in technical school or university.

34. Jefferson County Displayers Chapter (Wisconsin Wild Turkey Federation)

Must be a graduate from Jefferson County and major in Wildlife Conservation.

35. Jefferson County Farm Bureau

Available to students whose parents hold an active (voting or associate) membership in Jefferson County Farm Bureau. Student must be attending a Farm and Industry Short Course or any 2 or 4 year degree in any field. Does not need to be agriculture-related.

Amount: \$500 ea. (2)

Deadline: 4/25/2012

36. Jefferson County Masonic Lodge #9

Scholastic excellence – school and community participation.

Amount: \$1,000

Deadline: 3/26/2012

37. Jefferson County Reporter Advertiser Scholarship

Must be enrolled in either a 4-year college or vocational/technical school – special consideration is given to students pursuing a degree in journalism, graphic arts, communication or a related field, but is NOT necessary.

Amount: Varies

Deadline: 3/15/2012

38. Jefferson County Tavern League Hospitality & Food Service Scholarship

Good for 2 or 4-year college or technical school – course of study must be in the food service or hospitality field.

Amount: Varies

Deadline: 3/15/2012

39. Jefferson High School Eagle Theatre Council

Candidates for this scholarship must be actively involved in a minimum of 2 ETC productions to be considered. Emphasis in the application should reflect how actively the candidate has participated in drama club and ETC events. Special consideration will be given to those pursuing a degree or certification in theatre, but all candidates will be legitimately considered. (A strong candidate not pursuing a theatrical education can “beat out” a candidate pursuing theatre.)

40. Jefferson Lions Club - Robert Cowley Memorial Scholarship

Must be in upper 1/3 of graduating class and attend college or technical school.

Amount: \$500 (2)

41. Jefferson Rotary Club Scholarship

The Jefferson Rotary Club annually awards scholarships to deserving graduating high school seniors who reside in the School District of Jefferson. The aggregate amount of the scholarships usually exceeds \$10,000 annually. A committee of Rotarians that varies from year to year selects scholarship recipients. The scholarships are awarded to those applicants who best exemplify the ideals of Rotary as determined from the scholarship applications and personal interviews. In selecting a scholarship recipient, the committee reviews each application for originality and honesty of thought and expression. While there is not a set format, the application should be legible and demonstrate forethought and commitment. This scholarship is not based on need and is available to students pursuing a degree at a college, university, or technical school.

42. Jefferson Sno-Hawks Snowmobile Club Scholarship

Must be a graduating senior with at a least a C average. Must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited college, technical school, or an apprenticeship program. Must have demonstrated an appreciation and concern for our natural resources. Financial need will be a consideration.

43. Jefferson Sportsmen’s Club Scholarship

Must have at least a “C” average and enter conservation, natural resources or related study.

Must be a son, daughter, grandson or granddaughter of a member of the School District of Jefferson Support Staff Federation – must be accepted into either a 4-year college or vocational/technical school program.

45. Kiwanis Citizenship Award

The Kiwanis Citizenship Awards are designed to recognize “all-around” students for contributions made to their schools, homes, and communities. They will have demonstrated positive leadership, unselfish service, and willing involvement. This is a \$2,000 cash award and is paid directly to each winner, a male and a female, upon presentation of his/her first semester grade report from a recognized college, university, vocational college, or technical school, proving successful completion of the semester as a full-time student (at least 12 credits) in good academic standing.

46. Tyler Kreklow Memorial Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship award is to provide financial assistance for a graduating senior in financial need to continue his/her education at a technical school of their choice.

Must have obtained a grade point average of 2.75 or above. Based on extracurricular, community and church involvement.

Must be a graduate of Jefferson High School and have been in attendance for at least four semesters.

Amount: \$2000

49. Brett Magritz Memorial Scholarship

Must be a Jefferson High School graduate and attended for at least four semesters. Must have maintained a 3.2 cumulative GPA over seven semesters. Must have participated in at least two sports over their high school career.

50. Dr. John L. Phelps Memorial Scholarship

Open to all Jefferson High School graduating seniors.

51. Duane L. Quale Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to students pursuing Associate Degree at a Technical College or Bachelors Degree at 4-year college or university. Two scholarships are awarded to one female recipient and one male recipient. Qualifications include minimum 2.75 GPA, involvement in extracurricular and community activities, athletic participation, must have abided by the athletic code and shown leadership as team member and school citizen.

52. Reinel Law Enforcement Scholarship Fund

For students pursuing a career in police and/or forensic science.

53. Trisha Rockstroh-Kerr Memorial Scholarship

The recipient shall be a graduating student from Jefferson High School and must have attended Jefferson High School for at least four semesters. The student must have obtained a grade point average of 2.6 or higher after seven semesters of coursework. The student shall have high moral character and have set high standards for him/herself. The student must have a strong desire to help others as evidenced by the types of activities they have been involved in outside of the classroom. The student must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited college/technical school.

Open to all students pursuing an associate degree or apprenticeship program at a technical college.

Must have participated in athletics all four years. Minimum GPA 2.50 preferred – enrolled in a 4-year college or accredited technical school.

56. Norman and Carolyn Stoner Scholarship

The candidate shall be a graduating senior from Jefferson High School and must have attended for at least four semesters. Must have maintained an overall GPA of 2.75 or better. Must be enrolled at the Madison Area Technical College during the upcoming school year after high school graduation.

57. Dr. Brian T.S. Turley Health Care Profession Scholarship

Must be majoring in a health care profession.

Must attend a full-time, two- or four-year college course resulting in a degree. Must be a direct descendent of a veteran. Must be in the top 75% of graduating class.

Must be a legal dependent, grandchild or spouse of a Vietnam War veteran and currently reside in Jefferson County.

61. Watertown Regional Medical Center - Health Careers Scholarship

For seniors entering an associate degree or bachelor's degree program in a health care career. Preference will be given to candidates ranking in the upper one-third of their graduating class. Participation in school and community activity, related job experience, reasons for choosing healthcare. Financial need is also a consideration.

62. Donald “Choc” Wegner Memorial Scholarship

For seniors entering a two- or four-year college or technical college. Must have attended Jefferson High School for four semesters. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75. Selection is based on leadership and moral standards.
