2. Scholarship amounts and dates vary each year according to direction from sponsoring organizations.
3. Each year, new scholarship information is received after this booklet is distributed. **New scholarships will be listed in daily announcements** and will be available in the counseling office.
4. Many industries have scholarships available for sons and daughters of their employees. Students and parents are encouraged to determine their eligibility for these scholarships by contacting the **personnel office at their place of employment.**
5. Students should **check with specific colleges/universities** to determine their eligibility for scholarships and to receive scholarship applications.

- 19. Clarence C. Frohmader Memorial**
Anyone accepted at a 4-year college or technical school will be considered. Based on financial need, extracurricular activities, community services recognition/honors.
AMOUNT: \$2,500 DEADLINE: March 29
- 20. Frontier FS Cooperative Scholarship**
Must be a graduating senior in the immediate family of a patron that purchases from Jefferson County Farmco Cooperative a minimum of \$2,000 during the current fiscal year. Must be entering a college, university, farm short course, or vocational technical college in Wisconsin and studying agriculture or a related field.
AMOUNT: \$500 DEADLINE: February 1
- 21. Gemuetlichkeit Scholarship**
Must maintain a 2.5 GPA during senior year. Open to all graduating residents of Jefferson School District, regardless of where they attend school. This scholarship is largely based on community service.
AMOUNT: \$500 DEADLINE: March 29
- 22. Fern Fernholz Goff Scholarship**
Based on scholastic achievement rather than financial need – must enroll in one of the 13 University of Wisconsin Campuses.
AMOUNT: Varies - \$400 (Approx.) DEADLINE: March 29
- 23. Grellton Conservation Club**
Available to any student pursuing a career in agriculture and natural resources at a two or four-year college or technical school.
AMOUNT: Varies DEADLINE: March 15
- 24. Dr. Robert Handeyside Memorial Scholarship -** (location: www.forthehealthcare.com)
Must be pursuing any health-related field.
AMOUNT: up to \$1,500 (3) DEADLINE: March 15
- 25. Debra Happ Memorial Scholarship**
For students pursuing a degree in a performing arts field. Must be a graduate of Jefferson High School and attended for a minimum of 4 semesters. Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher.
AMOUNT: \$2,000 DEADLINE: March 29
- 26. Scott W. Hulstein Memorial Scholarship -** (location: www.forthehealthcare.com)
For students pursuing a career in nursing or other health careers. Must be a high school graduate residing in Jefferson County. Must have a 3.0 GPA.
AMOUNT: TBA DEADLINE: April 25
- 27. Jefferson Chamber of Commerce Scholarship**
Must be a graduate of Jefferson High School and be employed by a business that is a member of the Jefferson Chamber of Commerce
AMOUNT: \$500 DEADLINE: March 29

- 37. Jefferson Lions Club - Robert Cowley Memorial Scholarship**
Must be in upper 1/3 of graduating class and attend college or technical school.
- AMOUNT: \$500 (2) DEADLINE: March 29
- 38. Jefferson Rotary Club Scholarship**
The Jefferson Rotary Club annually awards scholarships to deserving graduating high school seniors who reside in the School District of Jefferson. The aggregate amount of the scholarships usually exceeds \$10,000 annually. A committee of Rotarians that varies from year to year selects scholarship recipients. The scholarships are awarded to those applicants who best exemplify the ideals of Rotary as determined from the scholarship applications and personal interviews. In selecting a scholarship recipient, the committee reviews each application for originality and honesty of thought and expression. While there is not a set format, the application should be legible and demonstrate forethought and commitment. This scholarship is not based on need and is available to students pursuing a degree at a college, university, or technical school.
- AMOUNT: Varies DEADLINE: March 15
- 39. Jefferson Sportsmen's Club Scholarship**
Must have at least a "C" average and enter conservation, natural resources or related study.
- AMOUNT: \$1,000 DEADLINE: March 29
- 40. Jefferson Support Staff Federation Award**
Must be a son, daughter, grandson or granddaughter of a member of the School District of Jefferson Support Staff Federation – must be accepted into either a 4-year college or vocational/technical school program.
- AMOUNT: Varies DEADLINE: March 29
- 41. Kiwanis Citizenship Award**
The Kiwanis Citizenship Awards are designed to recognize "all-around" students for contributions made to their schools, homes, and communities. They will have demonstrated positive leadership, unselfish service, and willing involvement. This is a \$2,000 cash award and is paid directly to each winner, a male and a female, upon presentation of his/her first semester grade report from a recognized college, university, vocational college, or technical school, proving successful completion of the semester as a full-time student (at least 12 credits) in good academic standing.
- AMOUNT: \$2,000 DEADLINE: March 29
- 42. Carol Linse Memorial Scholarship**
Must have obtained a grade point average of 2.75 or above. Based on extracurricular, community and church involvement.
- AMOUNT: \$500 DEADLINE: March 15
- 43. Steven H. Lipperer Memorial Award**
Must be a graduate of Jefferson High School and have been in attendance for at least four semesters.
- AMOUNT: \$2000 DEADLINE: March 29
- 44. Brett Magritz Memorial Scholarship**
Must be a Jefferson High School graduate and attended for at least four semesters. Must have maintained a 3.2 cumulative GPA over seven semesters. Must have participated in at least two sports over their high school career.
- AMOUNT: \$1500 ea. (1 or 2) DEADLINE: March 29

- 45. Dr. John L. Phelps Memorial Scholarship**
Open to all Jefferson High School graduating seniors.
AMOUNT: \$500 DEADLINE: March 29
- 46. Duane L. Quale Memorial**
This scholarship is available to students pursuing Associate Degree at a Technical College or Bachelors Degree at 4-year college or university. Two scholarships are awarded to one female recipient and one male recipient. Qualifications include minimum 2.75 GPA, involvement in extracurricular and community activities, athletic participation, must have abided by the athletic code and shown leadership as team member and school citizen.
AMOUNT: \$1,000 each DEADLINE: March 29
- 47. Brad Russell Memorial Scholarship**
Open to all students pursuing an associate degree or apprenticeship program at a technical college.
AMOUNT: \$1,000 DEADLINE: March 29
- 48. Jule Smith Memorial**
Must have participated in athletics all four years. Minimum GPA 2.50 preferred – enrolled in a 4-year college or accredited technical school.
AMOUNT: \$200 DEADLINE: March 29
- 49. Norman and Carolyn Stoner Scholarship**
The candidate shall be a graduating senior from Jefferson High School and must have attended for at least four semesters. Must have maintained an overall GPA of 2.75 or better. Must be enrolled at the Madison Area Technical College.
AMOUNT: \$500 DEADLINE: March 29
- 50. Dr. Brian T.S. Turley Health Care Profession Scholarship**
Must be majoring in a health care profession.
AMOUNT: \$1,000 DEADLINE: March 29
- 51. VFW/VFW Auxiliary Scholarship**
Must attend a full-time, two- or four-year college course resulting in a degree. Must be a direct descendent of a veteran. Must be in the top 75% of graduating class.
AMOUNT: \$500 DEADLINE: March 15
- 52. Vietnam Veterans of America – Blackhawk Chapter 409 (Richard L. Bowers Memorial Scholarship)**
Must be a legal dependent, grandchild or spouse of a Vietnam War veteran and currently reside in Jefferson County.
AMOUNT: \$500 (2) DEADLINE: March 15
- 53. Watertown Regional Medical Center - Lisa M. Schneider Health Careers Scholarship**
For seniors entering an associate degree or bachelors degree program in a health care career. Proof of acceptance and enrollment into the institution of higher learning is required. Preference will be given to candidates ranking in the upper one-third of their graduating class.
AMOUNT: \$1,000 DEADLINE: March 15

54. Donald "Choc" Wegner Memorial Scholarship

For seniors entering a two- or four-year college or technical college. Must have attended Jefferson High School for four semesters. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75. Selection is based on leadership and moral standards.

AMOUNT: \$500

DEADLINE: March 29
