BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION®

Participating Schools: Sullivan, East, and West Elementary Schools and Jefferson Middle School

This school year alone, more than \$50 million can be earned by schools who participate in the Box Tops campaign. We all shop for groceries, sometimes two or three times a week—or more. By participating in this program, you can turn those shopping trips into easy cash for our schools; encourage your friends to do the same! Just look for the Box Tops logo on hundreds of products like Cheerios®, Hamburger Helper® and Kleenex®, in almost every aisle of the store. All you need to do is clip and send them to your school's Box Tops coordinator—each one is worth 10 cents for your school.

NICKELS FOR SCHOOLS®

Participating Schools: Sullivan and West Elementary Schools and Jefferson High School

The Kemps Nickels for Schools program is open to any public, private, or parochial school for grades K-12. The program allows participating schools to collect

specially marked milk caps and Nickels for Schools POP symbols from Kemps dairy products and redeem them for cash. Participating schools will receive five cents for each milk cap or POP submitted through the official redemption process and may earn up to, but not more than, \$10,000 cash per year (September 1 - August 31) from the Kemps Nickels for Schools program.

Through a vocational work project, high school students in Mrs. Barb Kasper's cross categorical classroom assist our participating schools in preparing the bottle caps for redemption.
